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IAM

The words "I AM" show up in the Bible more than 300 times. The first time is in **Genesis 15:1** and the last time in **Revelation 22:16**. In Genesis, Yeshua says "I am a shield to Abram." In Revelation, Yeshua says "I am the root and the offspring of David, the bright and morning star."

In **Exodus 3**, Yeshua appears in a burning bush to Moses and told him to get to Egypt and free the Israelites. Moses said "Who shall I say sent me?" **Exodus 3:13-14** "Then Moses said to God, Behold I am going to the sons of Israel, and I shall say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you. Now they may say to me, What is His name? What shall I say to them? And God said to Moses, I AM WHO I AM; and He said, This you shall say to the sons of Israel, I AM sent me to you."

IAM WHO IAM.

2,000 years before Yeshua appeared to Moses, Anunnaki (name means "who is he?) is the most powerful god of the Sumerians. Anunnaki might have had big questions about who created everything and because of that, he introduced himself as Anunnaki, which means "who is He?" He hoped by this name maybe one day someone would find the answers to who created everything. Egyptians worshipped Anunnaki as well and he was one of the main Egyptian gods. That's why when Moses asked Yehovah what I should say to the Pharaoh, King of Egypt, Yehovah said to Moses, "tell them my name is "I AM." Actually by introducing Himself by "I AM" Yehovah even answered to all Egyptians that the one that you worship Anunnaki was looking for me, too.

In the Gospel of John, Yeshua mentions He is "I AM" seven times.

Who is He Who lived and died to take away my sins?
